9th Annual Tom & Mom Cat Special

Every year, Oregon shelters are forced to end the lives of tens of thousands of perfectly healthy and friendly cats because there are not enough people willing to adopt them and shelters lack the space, money and staff to provide long-term care until homes can be found.

In 2008, approximately 60% of the 5000 cats that were taken into the Multnomah County Animal Shelter were euthanized. In Washington County, the news was just as grim – 65% of the 4251 cats taken in were euthanized.

Help Save Lives - Support the Tom & Mom Cat Special

This annual low-cost spay/neuter program, specifically designed for disadvantaged individuals, has helped more than **5500** cats over the past eight years. From Valentine's Day to St. Patrick's Day, participating veterinary clinics will perform **\$20** spay and **\$10** neuter surgeries on cats.
