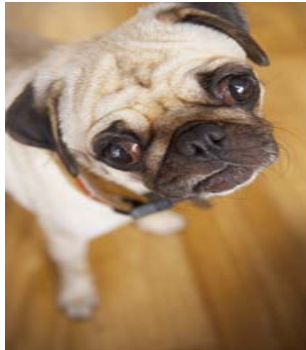

Canine Massage

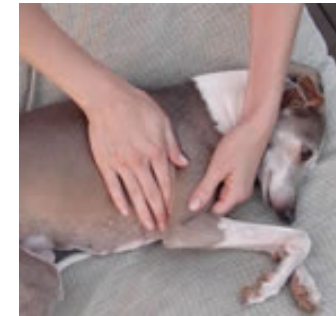
